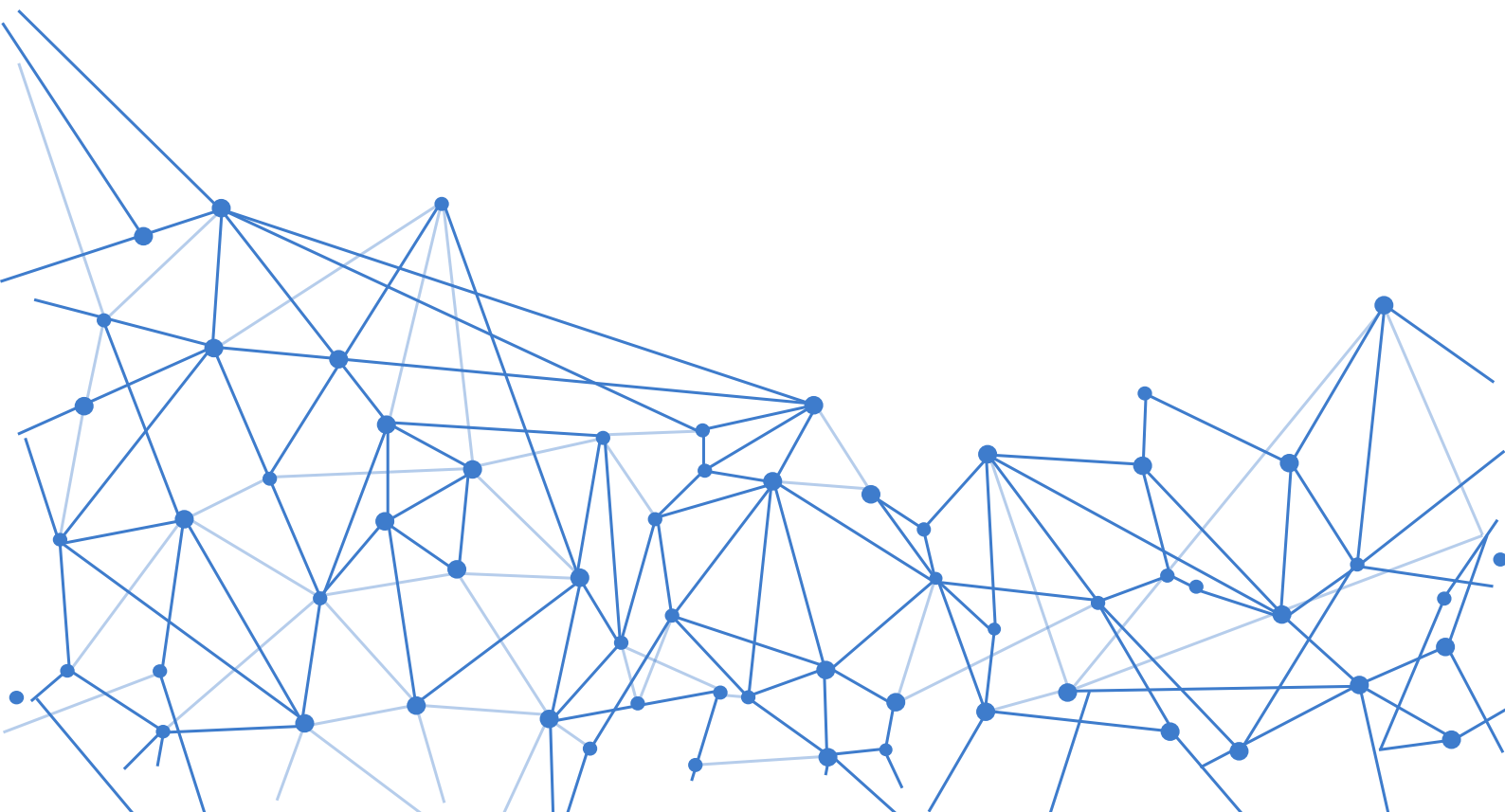

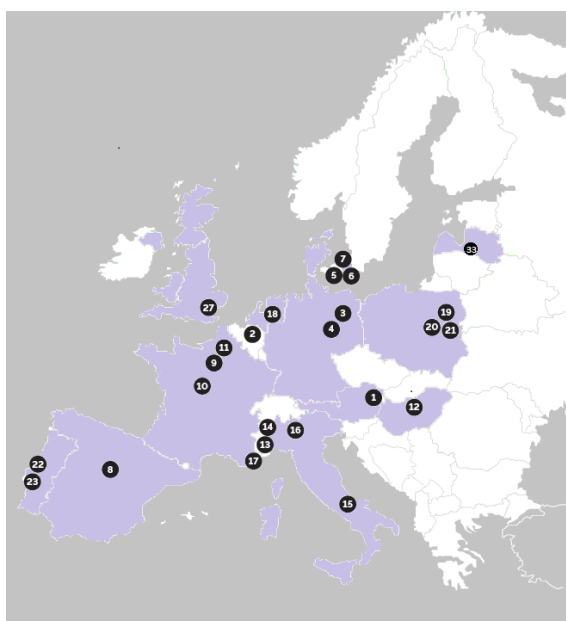

HORSING AROUND EUROPEAN COURTS COMMON TOOLS AND GUIDELINES

Horsing around European Courts is a joint European project developed by the Network of European Royal Residences for 2024, within the frame of the Olympic Games' equestrian competitions hosted at the Palace of Versailles.

As part of the common European heritage, horses and equestrian arts is a topic of common interest for the palace members of the Network and "Horsing around European Courts" is the opportunity for the members to work together to raise awareness of European heritage, its values and its protection, for future generations.

"Horsing around" is an English word play meaning "joking and laughing together, pushing each other". Consequently, with "Horsing around European Courts" the Network of European Royal Residences invites families, teenagers and children, to travel from one European country to another and to enjoy the cultural offers, activities and program about horses and equestrian arts.

Aiming to develop a thematic cultural offer all around Europe, Horsing around European Courts is the 2nd joint project of the Network of European Royal Residences after "A Place at the Royal Table" implemented in 2018 within the frame of the European Year of Cultural Heritage.

THE TOPIC: HORSES AND EQUESTRIAN ARTS

The theme of horses and equestrian arts is a way to tell the story of European royal residences from an original point of view. Horses and equestrian arts are an essential part of the European Heritage, material and immaterial, and European royal residences have numerous links and connections with this specific heritage.



Kings ordered the construction of huge and magnificent Royal Stables by renowned architects on their estate. They are totally part of the building heritage of the European royal residences that must be preserved. Some of them are still in use, others were, or must be transformed. These stables have often been centers of excellence both in the selection of horses and in the development of the equestrian arts and the transmission of this knowledge.

These stables hosted the horses which were very essential in the life of a royal residence by the wide variety of purposes they served. They were used by the royal family, courtiers and visitors, were an essential part of festivities and they contributed to the manifestation of the monarch's power, etc.
