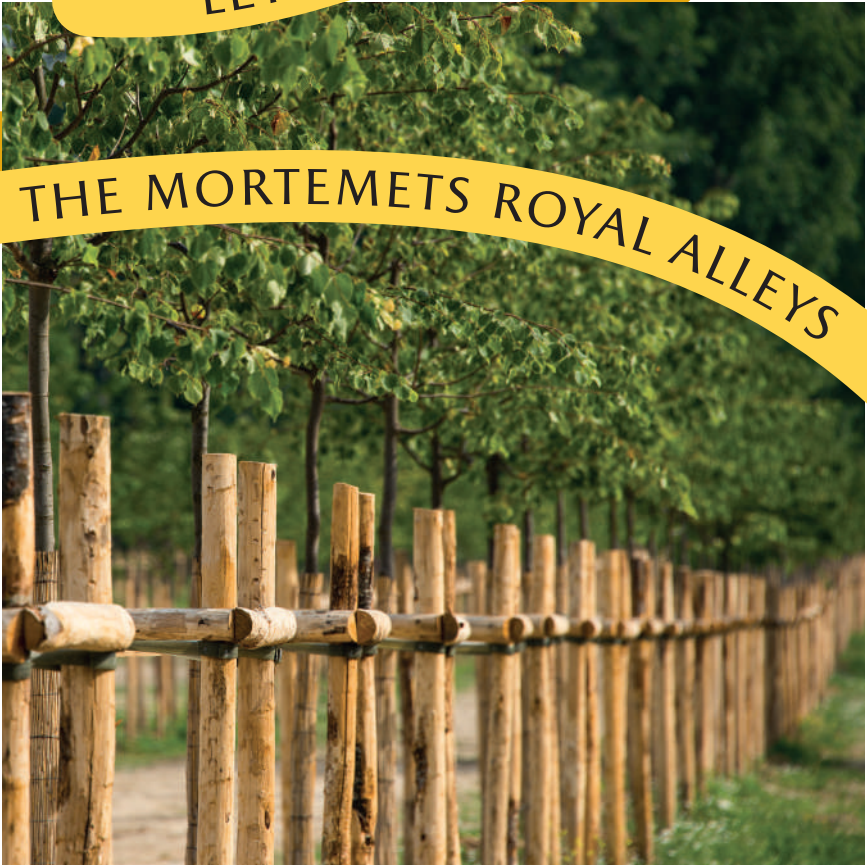

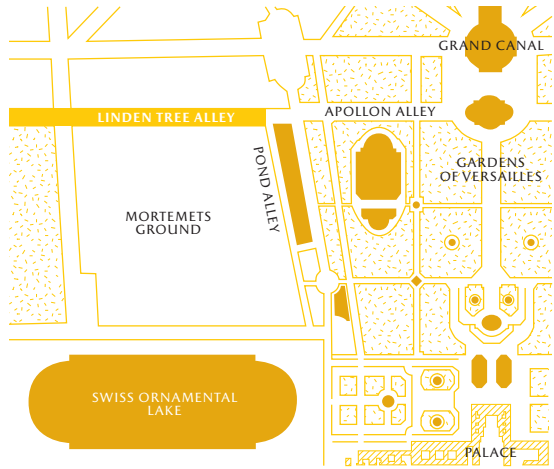
Thanks to your donations, the path lined with 523 linden trees will retrieve its original layout.

The Linden Tree Alley, which we are now replanting as an extension to the Apollon Alley used to link the Palace of Versailles to the “Mortemets”, a waterfowl reserve in the hunting grounds of Louis XIV.

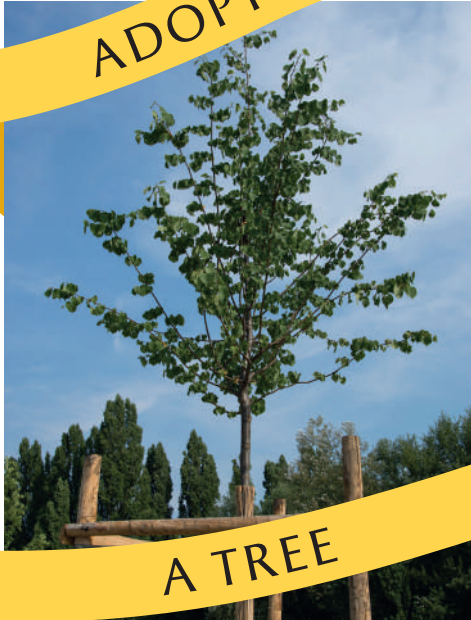
Integrated in 1662 in the great landscape composition designed by André Le Nôtre, gardener to the Sun King, it forms part of the famous perspectives of the gardens of Versailles.

SINCE THE STORM OF 1999, OVER 10,000 TREES HAVE BEEN REPLANTED!

After the storm of 1999, the commitment of our donors has made it possible to revive the perspectives sought by Louis XIV and restore the destroyed historical paths (the royal walk in Versailles, the royal walk in Marly). HOW TO ADOPT A TREE?

Private individuals and companies can make a donation and adopt one or several trees. The donation must be made by cheque using the form overleaf.

HOW MUCH DOES AN ADOPTION COST?

The adoption of a tree costs €1,000. This covers the purchase, transport, planting and maintenance of the tree for two years. For french tax payers: after the income tax deduction, it will only cost you €340 if you are a private individual or €400 if you are a company (income tax rebates of 66% and 60% respectively off the amount of your donation).

WHAT WILL YOU RECEIVE IN RETURN FOR YOUR GIFT?

- A personalised adoption certificate, in your own name or that of the person to whom you want to give it or dedicate it
- The subscription card "A year in Versailles", giving you unlimited access to the Palace for one year
- Your name will be included in the list of donors at the "Mortemets"
